



Immacula Hair Treating Hair Loss Problems

The new Capillscope system has three major functions. A special microscope that is run over a customer's head detects even the slightest residue on the hair and scalp.

Using a small sample of a customer's hair Oligario can test the oiliness or dryness level and the general health of the hair roots. She can tell if the root is receiving the proper nutrition.

Everything that the special microscope detects is instantly displayed on a computer monitor and the customer can see with her own eyes what is on her hair and scalp.

The computer analyzes the health of the hair and displays a chart of the current condition of your hair. The computer then suggests which specific products should be used to improve the health of the hair.

Oligario said that early recognition of a hair and scalp problem can help avoid problems such as hair loss in the future.

If hair loss is already a drastic problem Oligario may suggest a cosmetic solution such as a hair weave.

But she never forces her customers into any premature decisions. Once a problem is diagnosed she can suggest some corrective measures. She provides her customers with pamphlets so they can make an educated decision that is right for them. She urges women to go home and take the time to make a decision.

And if the decision is to treat the problem, the Immacula Hair Care Clinic can offer complete privacy to customers who fear being seen during treatment. New expansion work at the salon includes private rooms for massages and hair loss treatment. A customer can rest comfortably knowing that their hair loss will be treated with intimacy.

Oligario said that women who test the health of their hair early enough may be able to take the preventative approach and avoid hair loss.

Oligario even offers free hair analysis on weekdays. This can save a customer \$75.
